Missouri's First

Grocery stores were questionable places in 1852 if we may believe this section of the by-laws of Sedalia, Missouri's first lodge:

Visiting a grocery store for the purpose of playing cards, or any other game of chance, shall be found guilty of un-Masonic conduct.

And the Lodge did a banking business among its members:

On motion, resolved that the W.M. in the absence of the treasurer be authorized to loan any money on hand belonging to the lodge and not needed for the expense of the lodge upon such terms as shall be conducive to the interest of the lodge.

In later records we find that a rate of 6 percent was conducive to the interest of the lodge.
