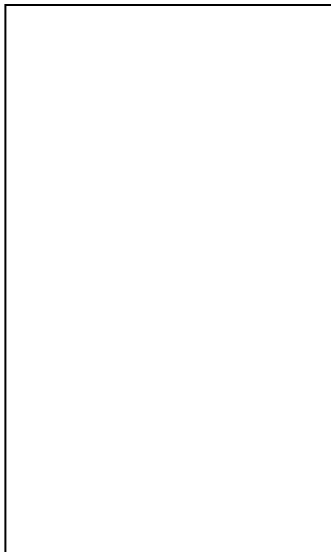

## 200<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Projects

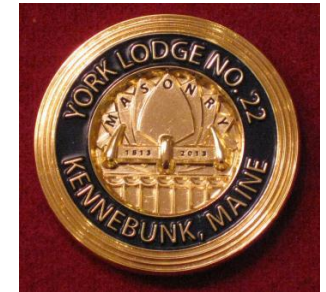
### *Things are Happening !!!*
