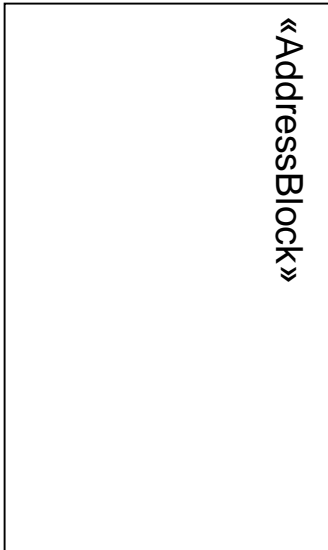

Brethren,

Well despite the snow, we managed to have a short **Stated Meeting in February** which mainly paid the rent, draped the charter for a departed Brother and continued everything else to the March 2<sup>nd</sup> Stated Meeting.

Things are happening none the less. We attended and participated in a **Master Mason degree** on Feb 6<sup>th</sup> at Harmony Lodge in Gorham. The candidate was an active duty member of the military and the degree was conducted by a group of veterans and active duty military. This group, ably led by MW Wayne T. Adams, has now conducted forty-nine time such military degrees and it would be really worth taking time to attend the next one. We will get notice out as soon as one is scheduled.

Although there is no charge it costs \$65 to process the test and register the results in the national database, so even if you cannot be a bone marrow donor you could help with a donation to defray these expenses.

And who knows we might even come up with some coffee and donuts.

The **York Lodge Officers** will be rehearsing on Monday evenings at 6:00 pm. Officers please plan to attend. Our floor work is changing this year and we need everyone present to make sure we don't run into each other. This includes our designated; 3 gates, speaking and nonspeaking Fellowcrafts.

It is a reasonable easy job, no lines to learn, but lighting plays an important part in our degree work. It would be also be necessary for the electrician to attend rehearsals.
