In Hammer v. State, 173 Indiana, 199 (1909), the Supreme Court ruled that it was a criminal offense to wear the emblem of any society or organization of which one is not a member. The court based its decision on the fact that the membership in such societies is the result of fitness and selection and that the wearing of such emblems by non-members is a deceit and false pretense.

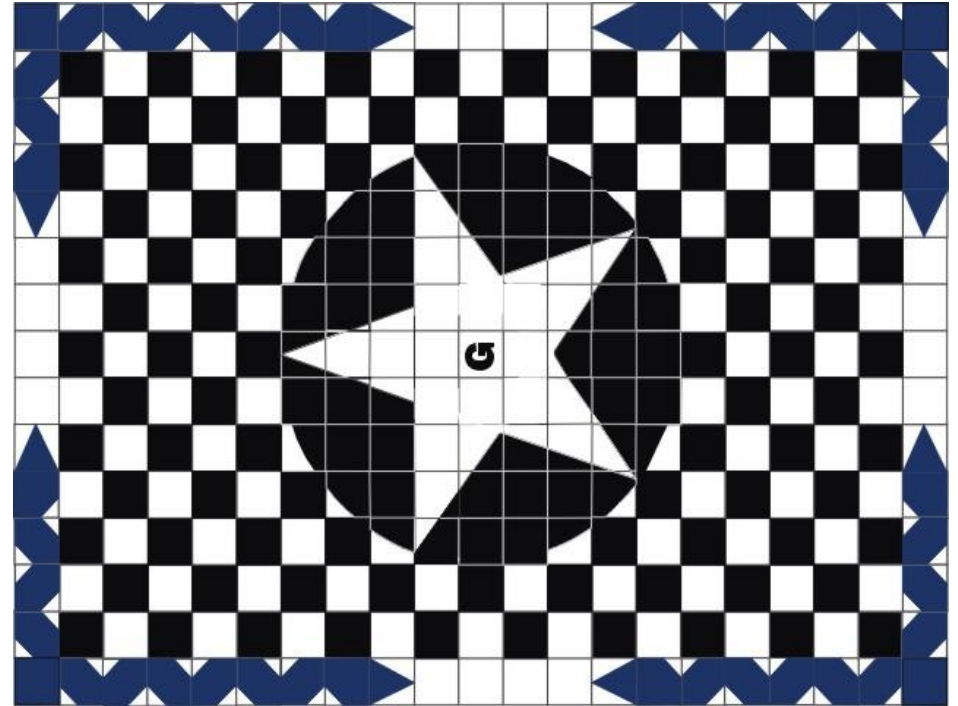
The Master's Corner

I would like to report to all of you that a wonderful design has been drawn on our Trestle-Board. This design was drawn by our Junior Deacon, Bro. Dan Fink. Bro. Fink clearly has a great grasp of the history, myths and development of Masonic Temple Mosaic Floors, Blazing Stars and Tesselated Borders. His presentation on this subject at our last state meeting was extremely informative. He is now gathering the information necessary to estimate the total cost of this project. My hope is that it will be finished before March 2013 in time for our Bicentennial Celebration. Bro. Steve Michaels has already also been very proactive in assisting the Lodge in the pricing of this glorious addition to our Lodge.

The preferred method of funding this project is to sell each tile as a unit of sponsorship of the project. Each tile will be priced to not only fund this project but also so that all other necessary repairs that have been done to the building and those that remain to be done can also be funded.
