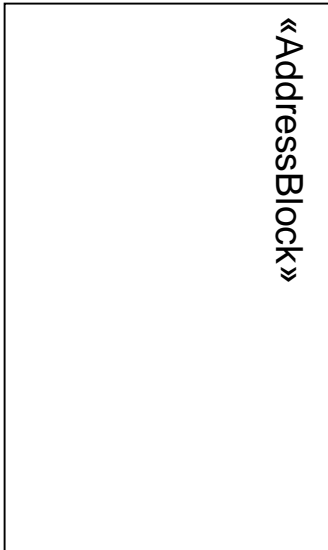

## Bikes for Books Committee

*Things are moving quite rapidly in our Bikes for Books program. First, we have been joined by two more lodges in our district, Ocean #142 and Yorkshire #179. They are working with Wells Elementary and Berwick Elementary Schools. If all goes well and I am sure it will we may pick up one or two more for next year.*

*We have the orders in for all of the Bikes and hope to see them in time to allow us to do our “Christmas Eve” build day on April 17<sup>th</sup>. Keep an eye on the District Calendar on the Grand Lodge website it has the most current information on our schedule.*

*We will need help in the following areas:*

**\*\* Sorting and building the bikes; since this is a four lodge effort we don't to end up with more people than bikes but we will need at least four or five per lodge.**

**\*\* QA and management; Someone is needed at the end of the process to fine tune and adjust so they all look alike and work, then the bikes, helmets and shirts have to be sorted by delivery sequence, labeled and managed. This is very important to keeping everything running smoothly on the awards day.**

**\*\* Delivery and set up at the schools; we have transportation to the schools but will need hands to load, unload and set up. There will be at least one awards day per school and we have a total of six schools this year.**

*We have an award day scheduled for Kennebunk Elementary on Friday May 6<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 AM. We will get the dates on the others out as soon as possible.*

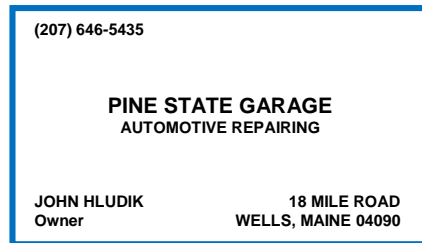
