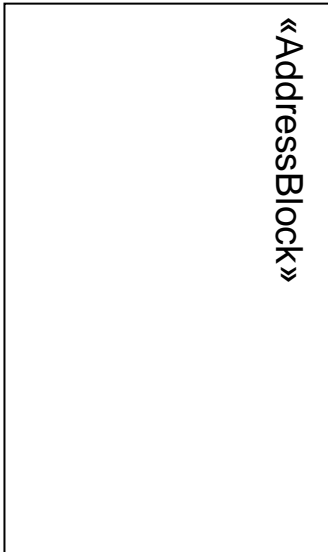

## **From the Craft**

### **A Thought...**

***As I sit here grading student work, dealing with their last minute panics, and getting ready to one more time close out a semester (I have been doing this for over 40 years), I think back on what new ideas and thoughts have come to me during this term's progress, and there are always some. In this process, though, there are some truisms here which I think are true for everyone.***

***Firstly, as we grow out of our teen years we, hopefully, begin to realize we don't know everything. This is not to demean or belittle what we know. It is only to say our knowledge may be imperfect or not complete, and we can learn how and where and gain from this. Also, we are not isolated or cut off, from the world around us, as we may sometimes feel and think, but part of a much larger one around us which unceasingly provides us input whether we see it or not. Input which we can use and learn from.***

***The second truism comes from this: there is much information which we can learn from and gain from IF we are willing to see it and learn from it. It is our choice. I, for example, always learn many things from my students, as I teach them in a class. They are bundles of knowledge and experience as I am also. Additionally as I prepare and gather information: there is always more to learn and the possibility of new ways to see things. I, personally, always find this amazing, for it means nothing is really static, our road always has potential, and we are only trapped in our mind if we want to be.***

***In our Lodge we have been assiduously working on our degree skills. All I have written here applies to this as well. For as we go through the ritual, hear it again and again, memorize more, and practice and practice: it opens up the paths of the degrees once more for us to think about and contemplate their meaning and perhaps see them and their message in a new light or way.***
