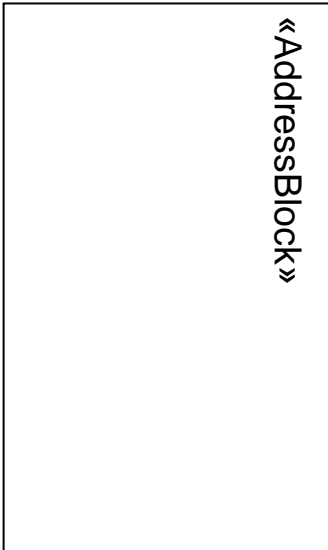

Composers who were Freemasons:

Frederick II (Frederick The Great)

Lived 1712-1786. King of Prussia and certainly one of the most able and enlightened monarchs the world has seen. He encouraged economic reforms and did much to improve the life of his people and his country. Mad a Mason on the night of August 14-15, 1738, at a special Lodge called Brunswick, he was a skilled musician, composing material for the flute and other instruments, and an accomplished flautist. He studied music under some of the most outstanding musicians of the day, and music played an important part in his court. Many of his compositions are still recorded and performed.
