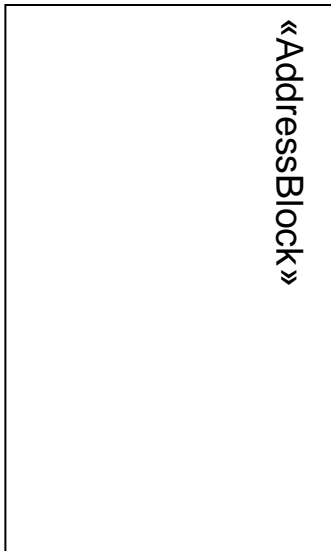

He was raised in Catoosa Lodge #185, Catoosa, Oklahoma, and had been awarded the Grand Cross of the Court of Honour in the Scottish rite in 1989.
