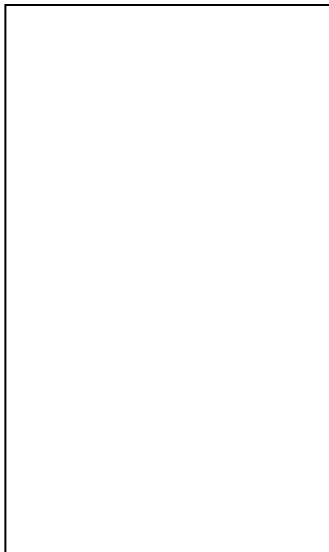

The Craft's Noyse:

Composers who were Freemasons:

Ludwig von Beethoven

Lived 1770-1827. It is uncertain whether Beethoven was a Mason. Hard evidence is lacking, and writers differ on the interpretation of the evidence which does exist, although a strong majority believe that he was a member. Certainly Neefe, Beethoven's teacher and friend, was a Freemason, as were many other of his associates and patrons, including his biographer and closest friend, F.G. Wegler. Wegler, who was also Beethoven's physician, wrote new words to two of Beethoven's songs for use in the Lodge. The song "Operfield" (Hymm of Sacrifice) became "Bei der Aufnahme eines Maurers" (At the Initiation of a Mason). "Der Freye Mann" (The Free Man) became "Maurerfragen" (Masonic Questions). Nettl points out that in a letter Beethoven wrote concerning the death of his brother. Karl, he mentions the acacia. In a letter to the Cardinal Archbishop, Archduke Rudolf, Beethoven wrote. "There is nothing greater in life than to get nearer the deity than other mortals, and to diffuse its light among men," a sentiment which is clearly Masonic. His opera, Fidelio, as well as the Ninth Symphony and the Missa Solemnis, seem to be purely Masonic in spirit.
