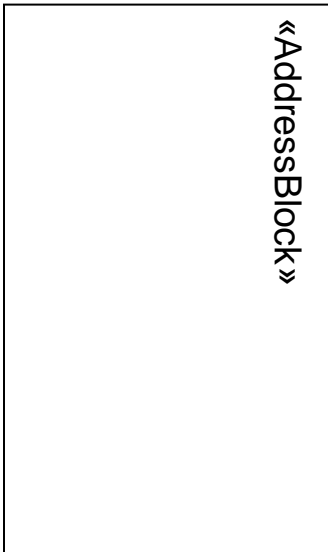

At the October Stated Meeting discussed the proposal for doing a **Masonic Bikes for Books** program for two schools in Kennebunk, the Sea Road School and Kennebunk Elementary. Better cost estimates were now available ant it was agreed that the program could be done within the costs presented. So, in January we will be attending an assembly at each of the schools to kick off the program which will run until April. Then in April,we will attend assemblies to assist in the awarding of the bicycles. This program promises to be an excellent incentive for the statewide literacy program, as well as a lot of fun.

We will, need some assistance from you. We will be acquiring 70 bicycles, which will have to picked up from the Grand Lodge delivery location, and then, of course, assembled. We hope to do this just before the awards so we don't have to store 70 bikes for long. Additionally, the Grand Lodge is providing a helmet for each bike and we will be printing tee shirts to go with them as well. We have met with the Principals of each school and they are very interested to get the program underway.

We also hope to get as many of the children and their new bicycles to ride in the May Day Parade, so we can show how hard they worked and what Masons do in the community.
